 - B. Graduate from high school in May 2010 / Presently attending two or four year college, university or trade school.
 - C. Have at least a 2.5 cumulative G.P.A.
 - D. Have provided community service to Kane'ohe Outdoor Circle, your school, and/or Kane'ohe community.
 - E. Must be entering OR Will be continuing at a 2 or 4-year college, university, trade school in the fall 2010.
